Marshall (gregmarshalldesign.com), an award-winning naval architect. The twin CAT C-32 engines (1600 HP each) deliver a 26 knot cruise with a maximum speed of 32 knots. She comes fully equipped with 15HP bow and stern thrusters, a Yacht Controller, Naiad Electric Stabilizers, and two Northern Lights generators. This yacht delivers a level of performance, reliability and safety for offshore cruising that will delight the most discerning yachtsmen.

With teak decks and generous seating in three beautiful yet unique spaces, you and your guests can truly relax in style and comfort. The Neptunus 750 Flybridge features an open boat deck aft, furnished to your taste with two teak lounge chairs and matching side tables. Forward, under the shade of the contemporary carbon fibre hardtop, are a settee on port, and two entertainment centers on starboard. Contemporary fabrics, quartz countertops and custom LED accent lighting make this space special by day or night.

The fully-featured helm includes full navigation electronics with redundancy, proportional bow and stern thrusters, and a Yacht Controller with joystick and remote. The three custom-stitched Pompanette helm chairs complement the flybridge appointments, while providing comfort for long days underway.

The cockpit below provides additional space for entertaining, and features a custom mahogany table with inlay and stainless steel pedestals. Solid teak decking rounds out the aft deck appointments.

With an 18'11" beam, the Neptunus 750 Flybridge features a bright, open design that is beautiful by day, and by night. Traditional cherrywood or walnut joinery accent the yacht's spacious interior, giving a complete sense of comfort and style. Washed in warm natural light, you will immediately feel at home in these surroundings.

The architect-designed centre galley layout creates beautiful flow and balance, while contributing to the spacious feel of the yacht. This fully equipped galley is ideal for extended cruising, yet equally at home when entertaining for an evening. The galley showcases your unique cabinet design, woodwork, and quartz or granite countertops. Forward is a dinette that seats six in style, and provides you and your guests with a 180 degree vista. Wing doors port and starboard allow for flow-through breezes while berthed, and provide convenient access to the walk-arounds as well.

You will find large windows on port and starboard, providing beautiful natural light for this signature stateroom.

This yacht is equipped with four staterooms and three heads.

The guest stateroom on port has two berths, while the twin VIP staterooms aft have queen size beds and adjoining ensuites. All staterooms feature hand-crafted quarter-cut cherrywood cabinets with extensive storage, luxurious appointments, and exquisite lighting. Every detail of the interior from choice of woods, accents, fabrics and hardware will be planned with you, for your enjoyment.

Practical by Design

The Neptunus 750 Flybridge is carefully designed with the owner-operator in mind. Nowhere is this more evident than in our engine rooms. The engine rooms are engineered to provide the easiest possible access to all the components and systems that you routinely use. The maintenance points are easily accessible from either side of the engines. Access to fuel filters, engine filters, oil change systems, strainers and pumps are designed with serviceability in mind. At the same time, the extensive use of sound insulation in the engine compartment keeps the yacht quiet while underway or at anchor.

But it doesn't stop there. Our helm stations are ergonomically designed to offer ease of use and redundancy. Every Neptunus 750 Flybridge has twin multi-function displays for navigation, 72-mile radar, twin VHF's, autopilot, a Yacht Controller with remote, proportional bow and stern thrusters with 5-stage dock hold position, and a computer-controlled stabilizer system. Over the years, Neptunus has earned its reputation as building a "boater's boat". Let us show you why.




